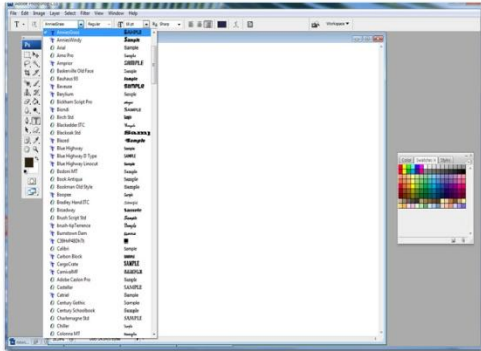


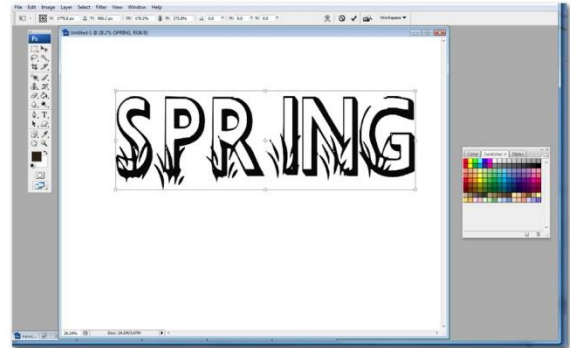


Make Your Own Wordart!

Learn how you can make your own customized Wordart images using any font of your choice and digital image cutouts. *Annie's Grassy Font and BaBees Image Cutouts were used with Adobe PhotoShop to create this tutorial.*



1. Open your Photoshop or image editing program and select the font you want to work with.



2. Use the typing tool to type out a word or phrase. You may need to resize before adding images.



3. Before painting the word, use your pen to close up any design gaps or broken lines. Merge the layers to create a lineart word.



4. Paint or fill the lettering with patterns or textures as you would with a lineart image.



5. Import .png image cutouts and then arrange them playfully in layers on and around the painted word. You can resize and move images in front of or in back of the wording!



6. I added another layer of simple green linestrokes to this sample to create more interest and depth. Background colors and shapes can also be added. Merge the completed layers and save as a .png image!
