

Life is a Picnic Basket

Painting Project

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Picnic Basket with wooden lid
- Acrylic Craft Paint baby blue, true blue, yellow, orange, red, light green, dark green, black, white
- Assorted Paint Brushes
- Clear Finish
- Sponge Brush

PREPARATION:

- 1. If necessary, lightly sand the wood lid and remove excess dust.
- 2. Resize pattern if necessary to fit lid. Pattern for original sample project is 12"x8".
- 3. Print pattern. Transfer pattern onto center of the lid using graphite paper.

NOTE:. You can re-tranfer pattern areas as needed

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Paint the background area with Baby Blue. Shade edges with True Blue.
- 2. Basecoat the sunflower characters with Yellow and let dry.
- 3. Mix a bit of Orange with Yellow to paint flower centers. Use thinned Orange to apply shading around the face area and tap a bit of red into the wet paint onto the cheeks before adding a. dot of Red to each nose.
- 4. Use yellow with a touch of orange to shade petals.
- 5. Leaves are light green shaded with dark green.
- 6. Lettering is painted with True Blue mixed with Black.
- 7. Bees are Yellow and Black. When dry, brush wings with White.
- 8. Open mouth area on sunflower is filled in with Black. Tongue is Orange.

FINISHING:

Use Black paint thinned to an ink consistency with a liner brush to add all outlines and details. **OPTIONAL**: Add a solid color border or dot flowers and leaves around the outside border edge When dry, apply a coat of clear sealer finish to protect the artwork.
